



Jefferson County Library Website Redesign

Student majoring in history 21 years old



Owner of a local small business 47 years old





The biggest change to the Jefferson County Library website mapping that I had made was simplifying and de-cluttering the amount of pages seen on the site map. The original site map was full of specific pages and information that could be easily be put within other pages, so I condensed down the total pages found in the menu allowing for a user of the site to quickly find a page of information that they are looking for rather than taking extra time looking through roughly 50 page titles. This simplified structure allows for ease of searching as well as allowing for a cleaner, more modernized website design look.
